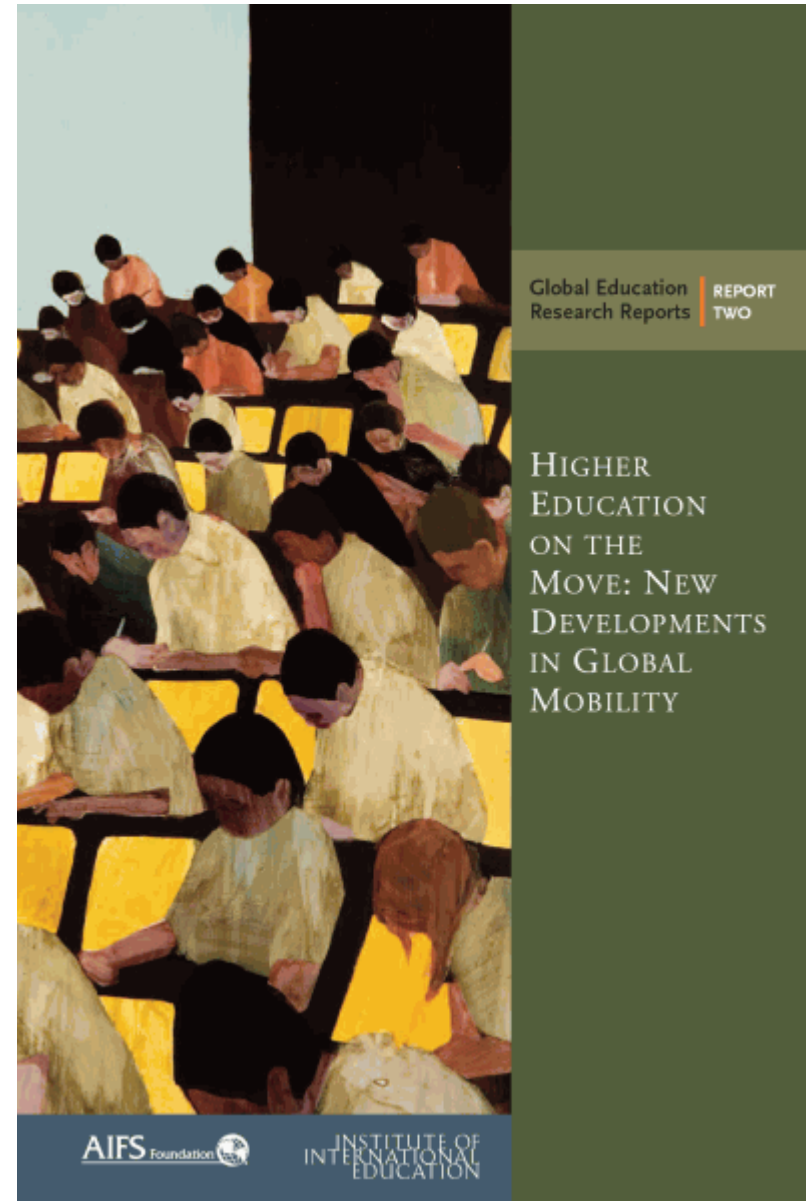

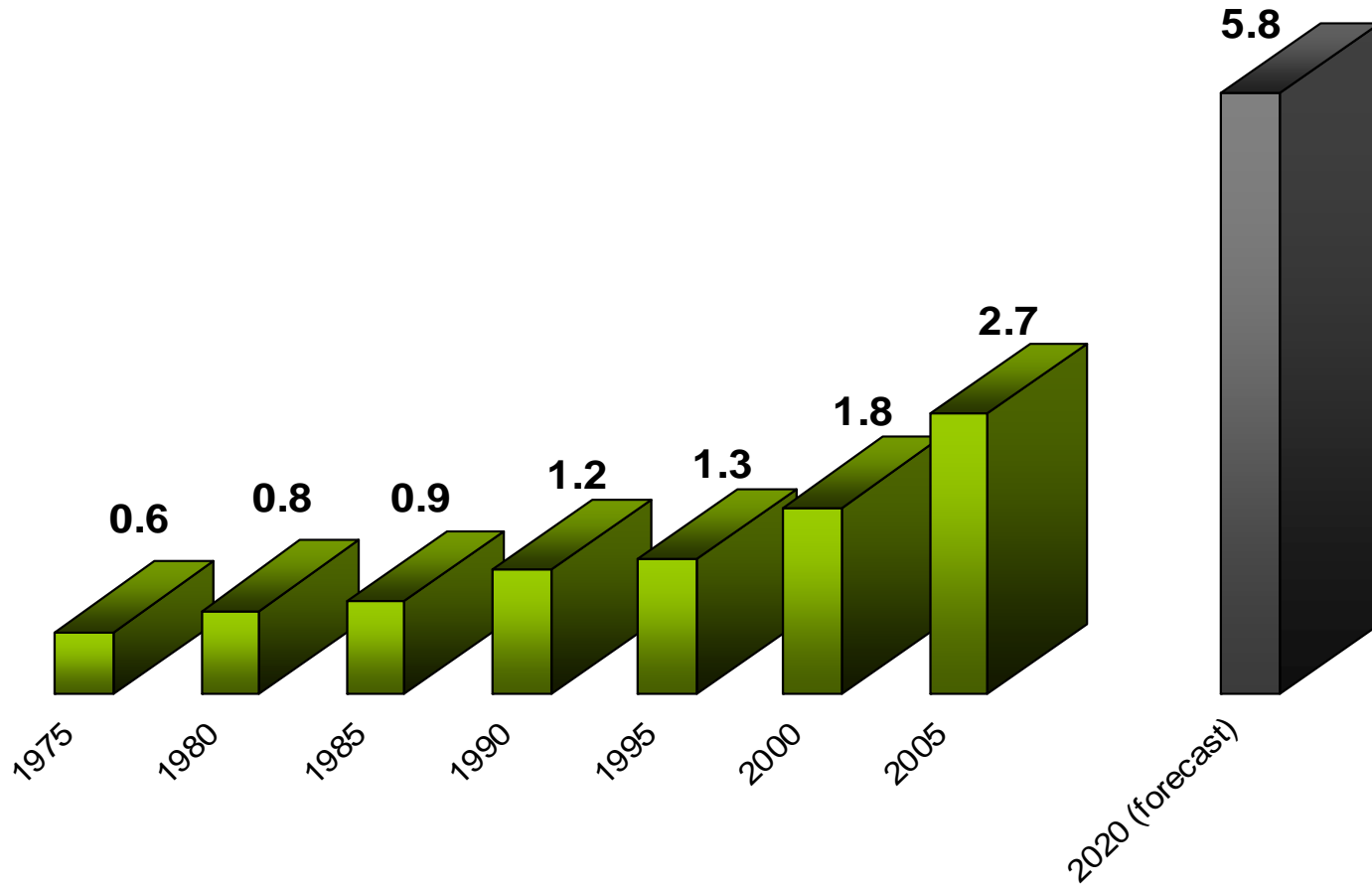
The Institute of Higher Education reports about 3 million students and scholars are pursuing degrees and conducting research in a country or culture beyond their own.

This represents a 57 per cent increase since the late 1990s.

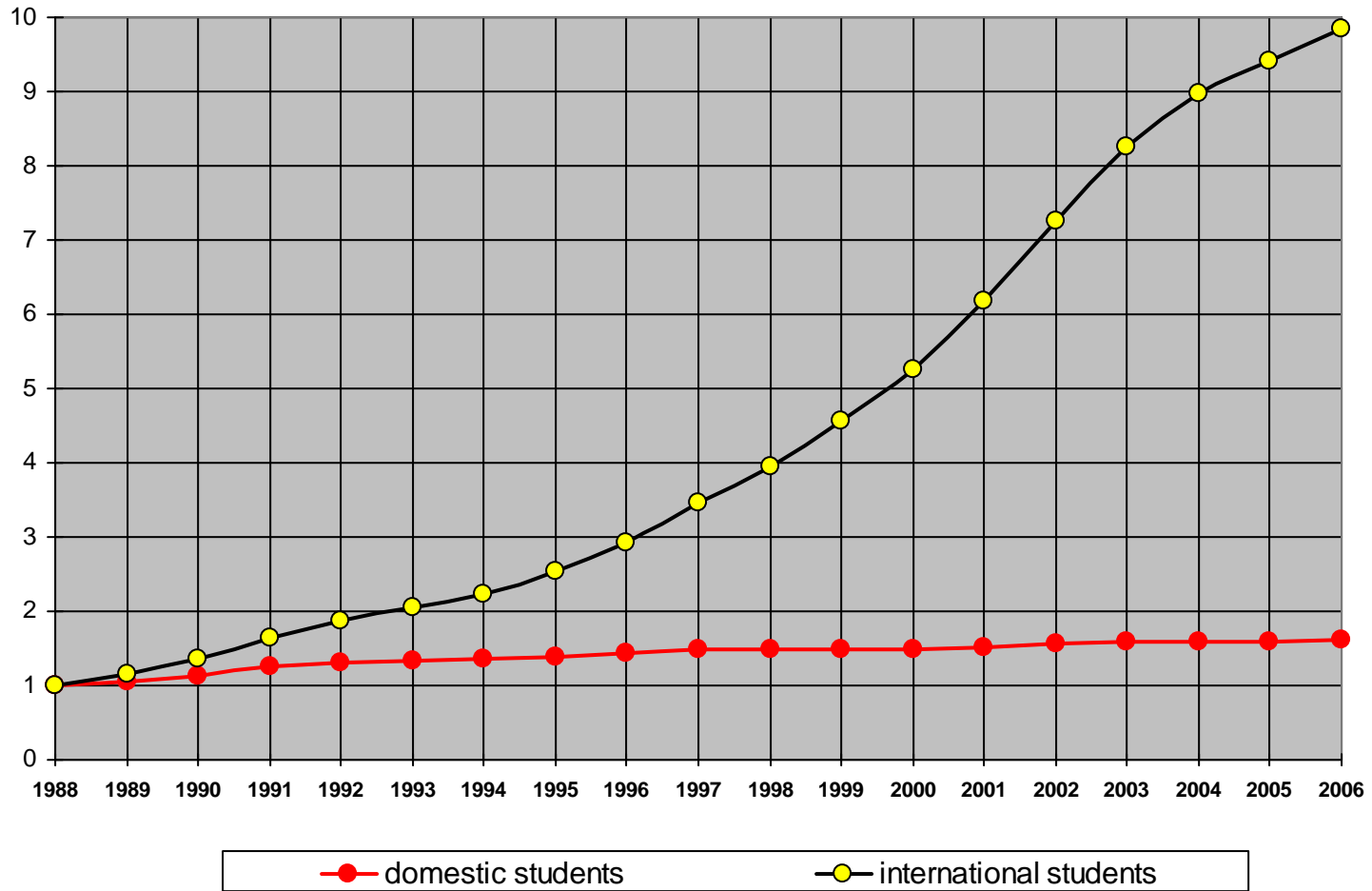

The case of Australia: vitally important growth



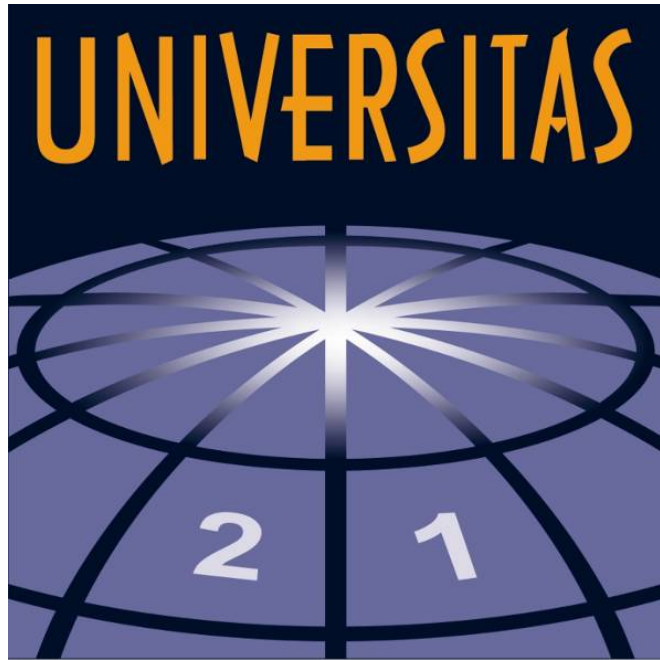

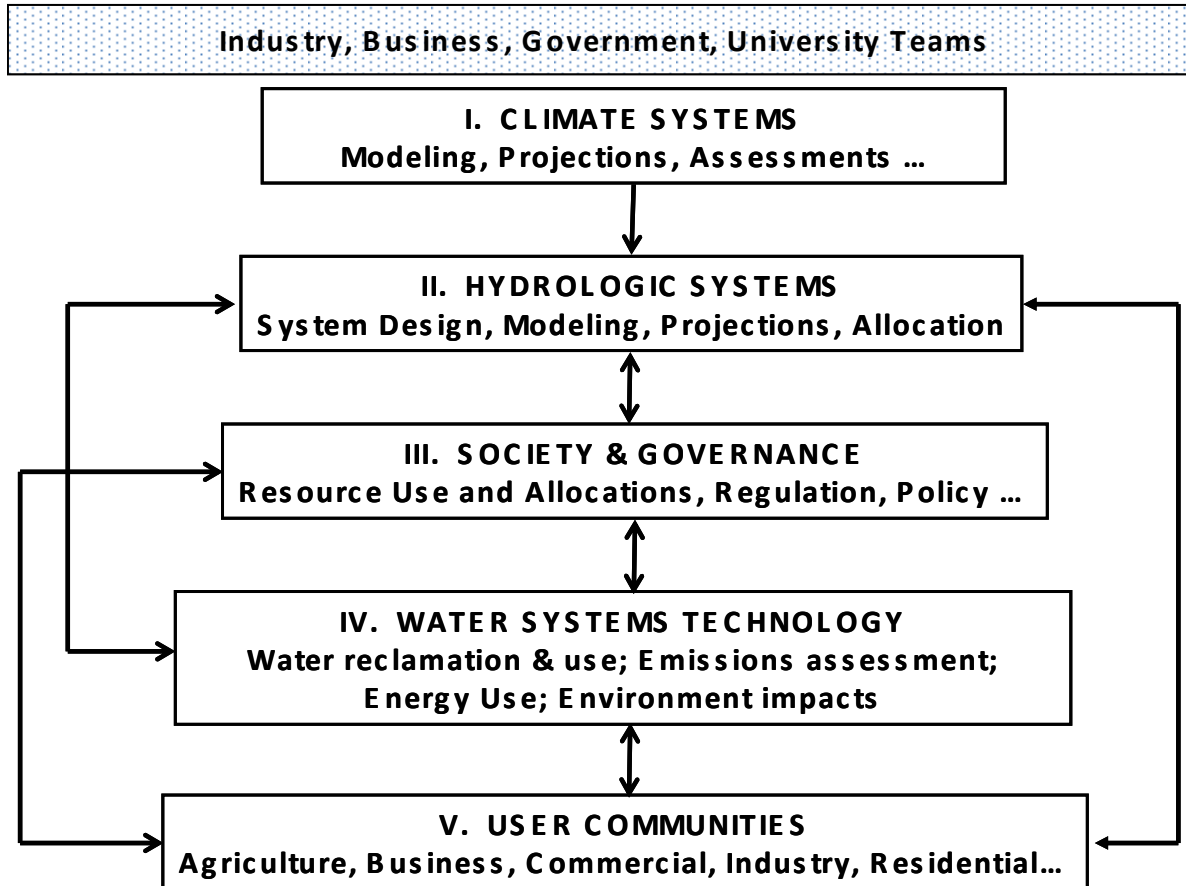
