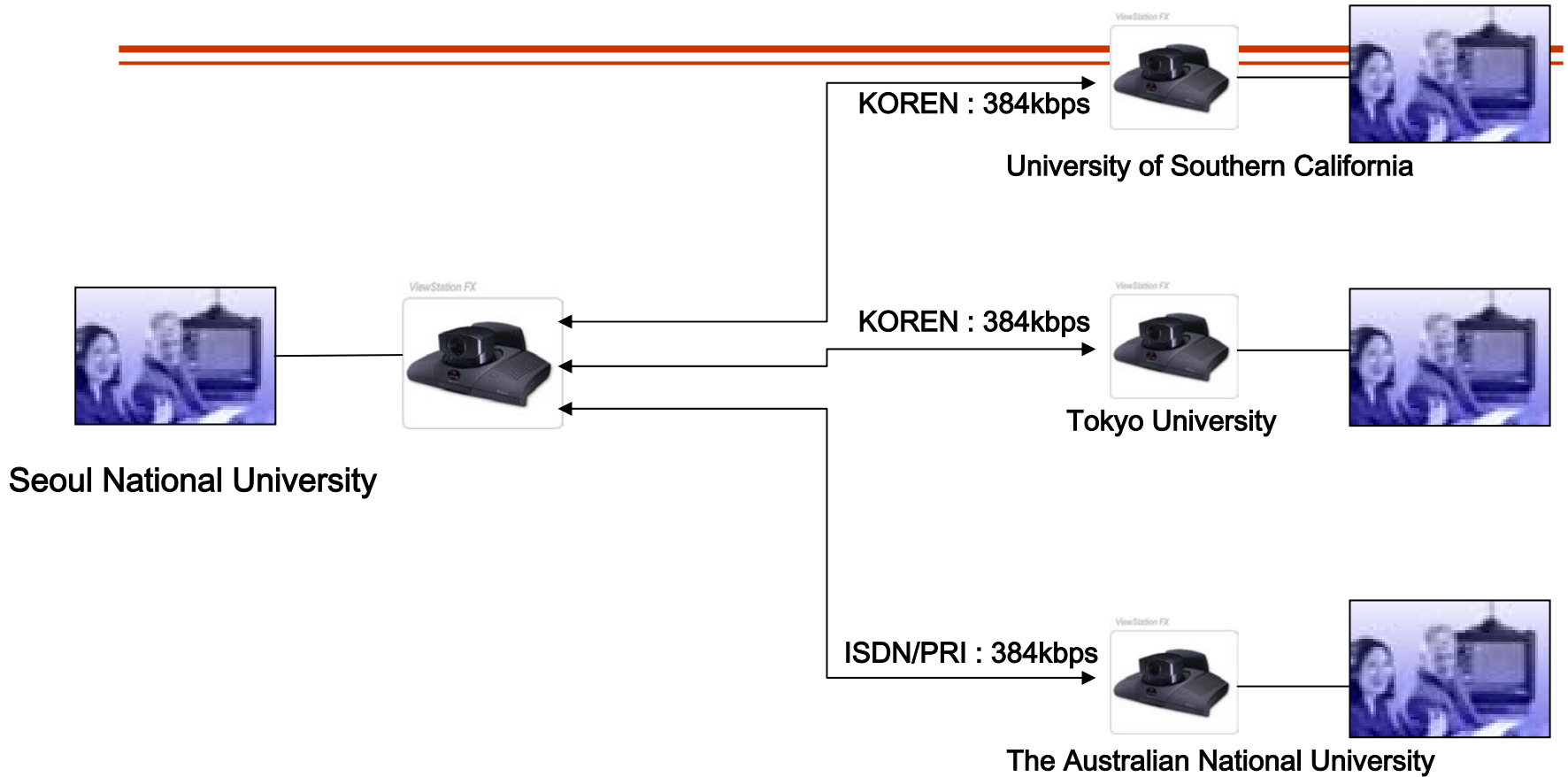
Report on APRU Presidents' Videoconference

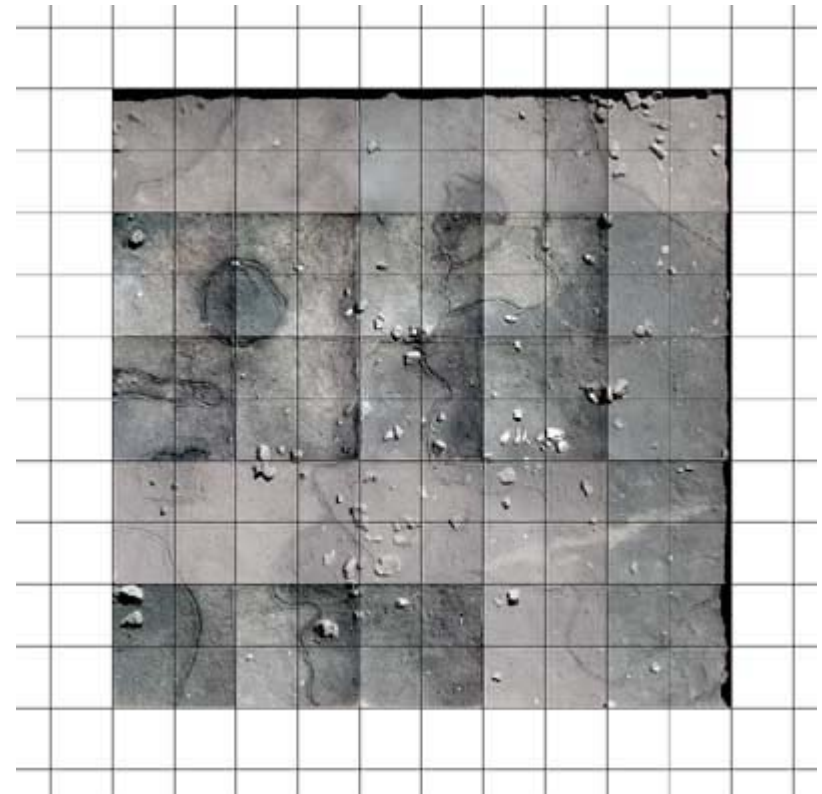
Early Tibet ~21,000 Years
