Earthquake Hazards around the Pacific Rim - Prediction and Disaster Prevention -

Dates: August 31 - September 2, 2005

Venue: Kyoto University Clock Tower Centennial Hall,
Kyoto, Japan

There are a growing large number of mega-population centers around the Pacific rim including East Asia that are prone to large earthquakes and tsunami, such as Los Angeles, Seattle, Tokyo, Osaka and Taipei. In addition, practically every city near member universities has some level of earthquake risk.

Earthquake engineering standards have improved over the last few decades, but because of population growth, yearly earthquake damage has not diminished significantly.

We will hold an international symposium in Kyoto, Japan from August 31 to September 2, 2005, which will bring together leading researchers in the fields of earthquake seismology, strong-ground motion studies, and earthquake engineering. The purpose of the meeting is to present recent findings and discuss topics for future research.

Many countries are actively involved in national seismic hazard programs, making worldwide comparisons useful. Also, the devastating tsunami in the Indian Ocean from the Sumatra earthquake of last year will receive special attention at the symposium.

We also encourage student participation in this symposium and will offer awards for student posters.

There will be optional activities on the third day, such as, a workshop on tsunami and earthquakes, a student session,

a walk along the Hanaore earthquake fault, or sightseeing in Kyoto.

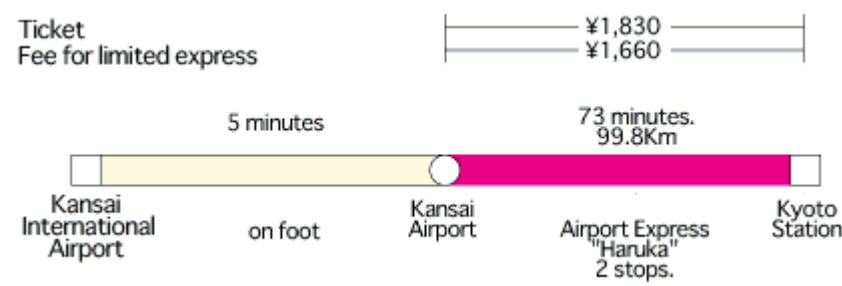

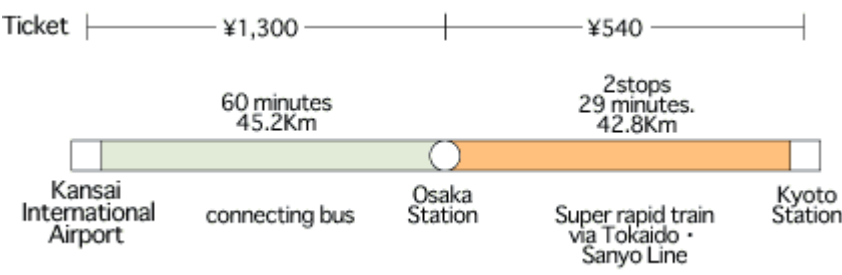

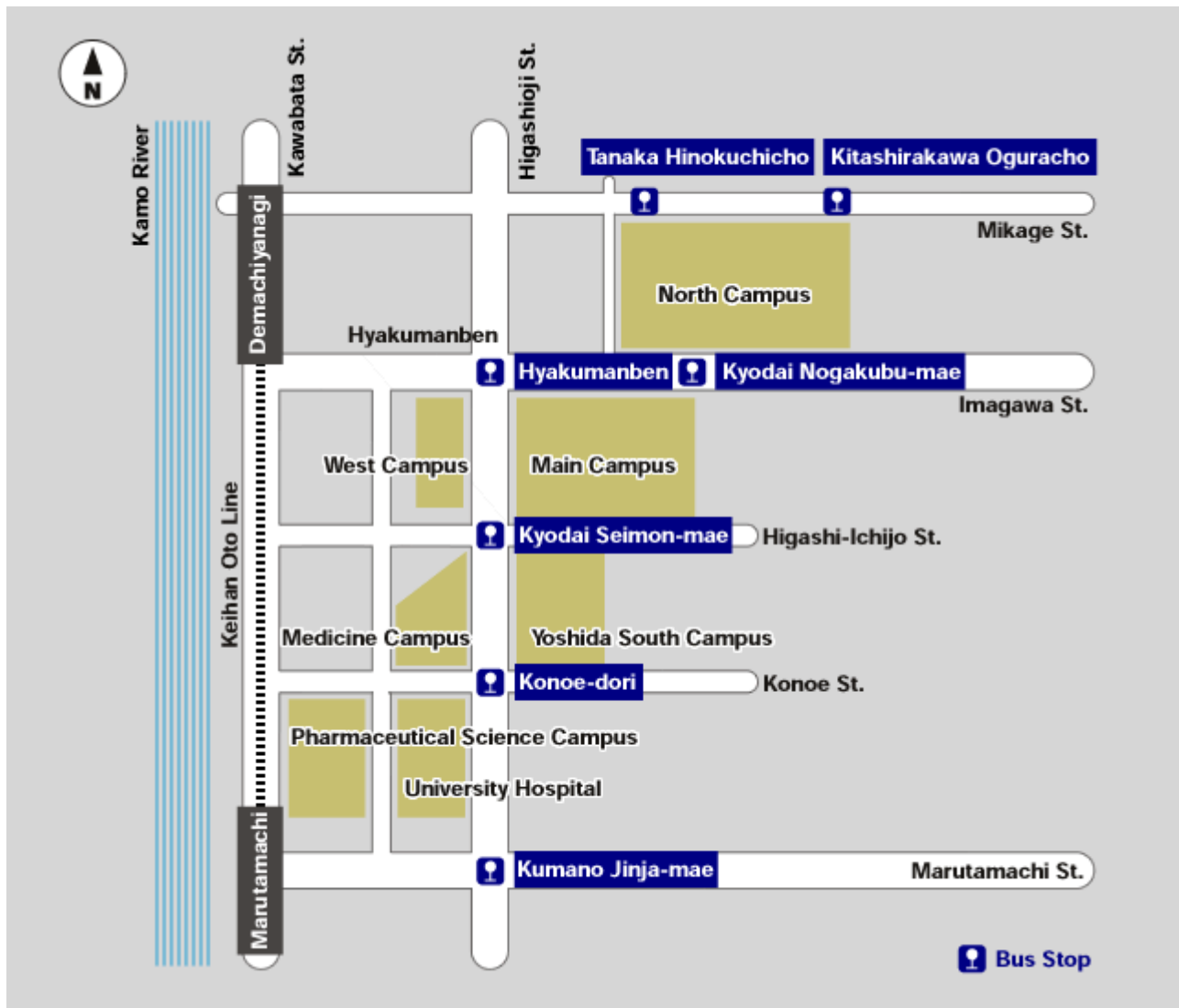

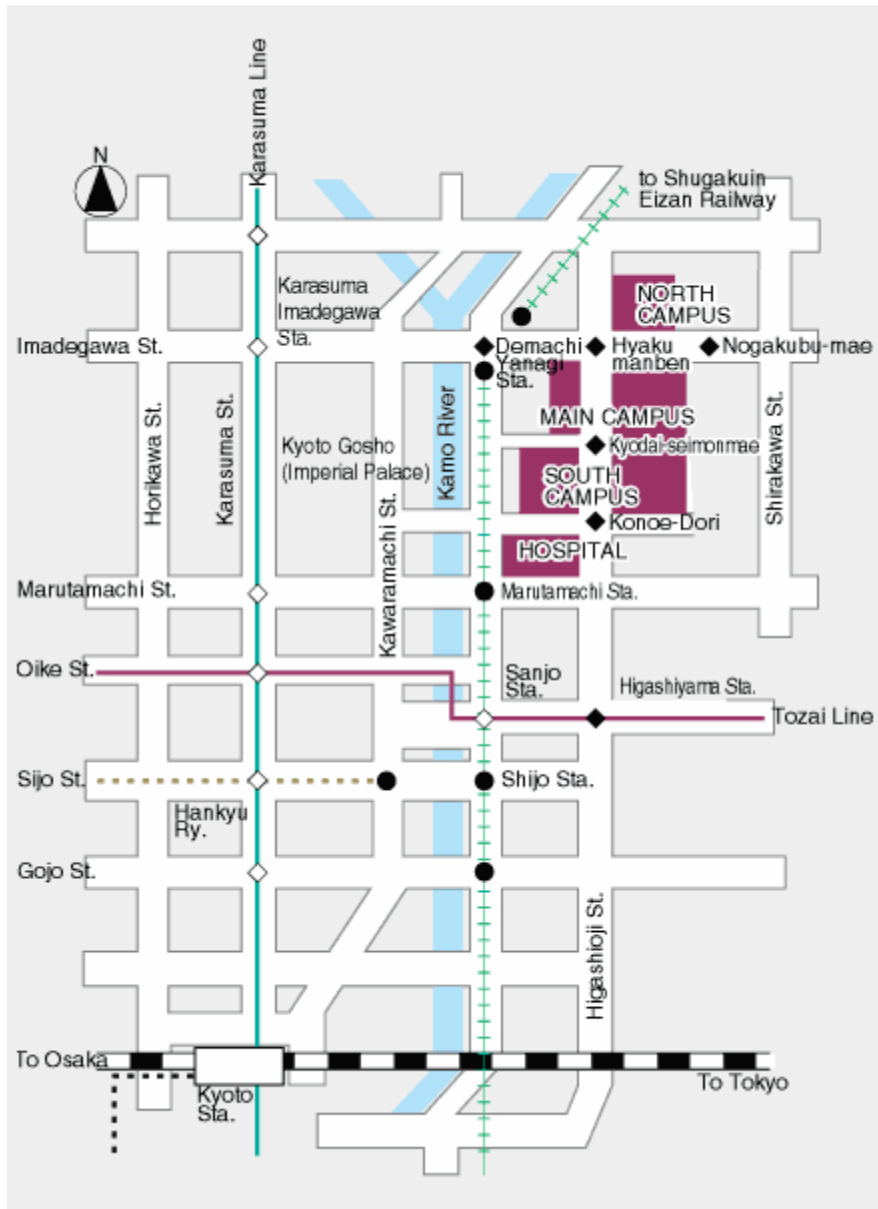

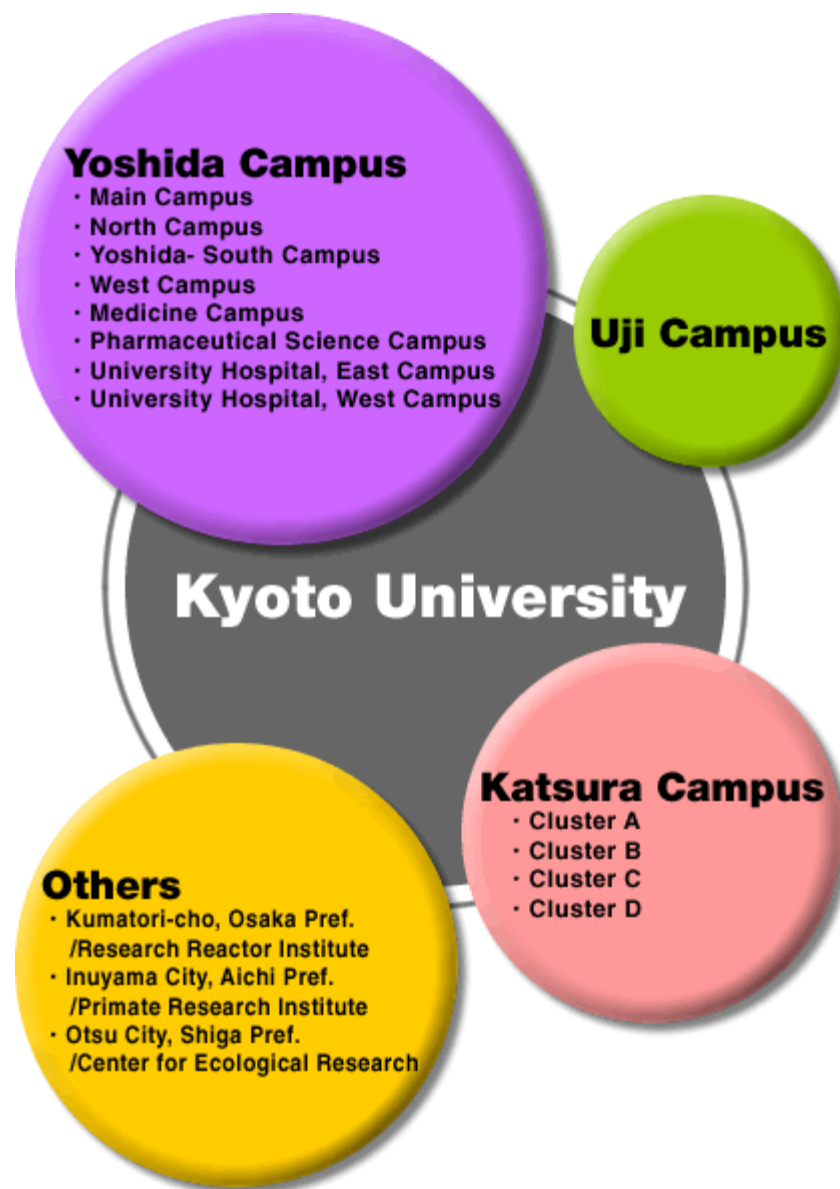

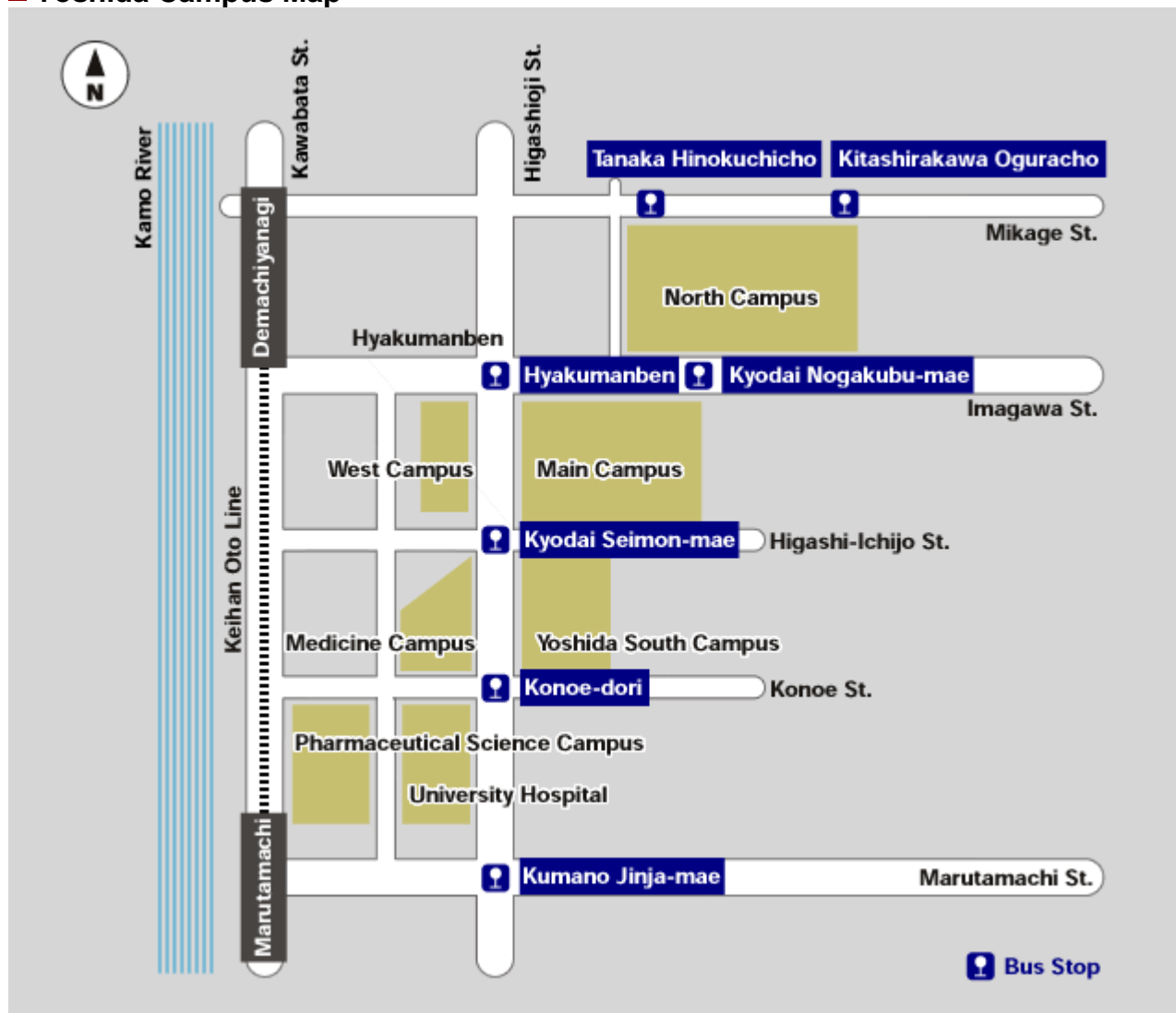
